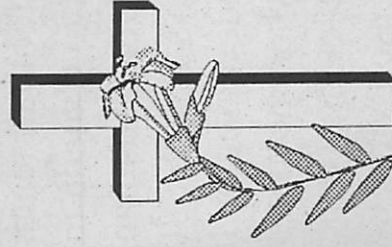
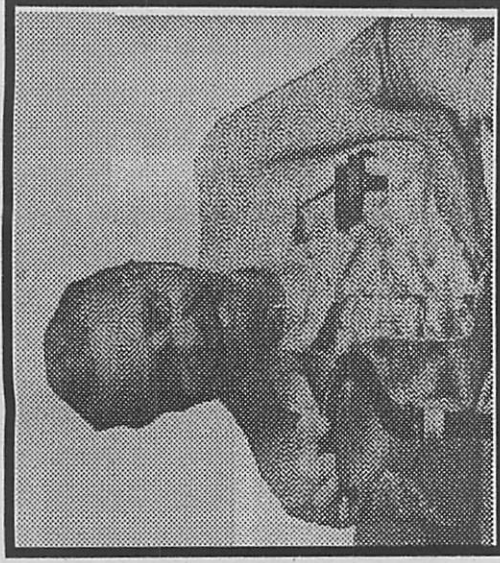

Jesse Samuel Hobson Jr.

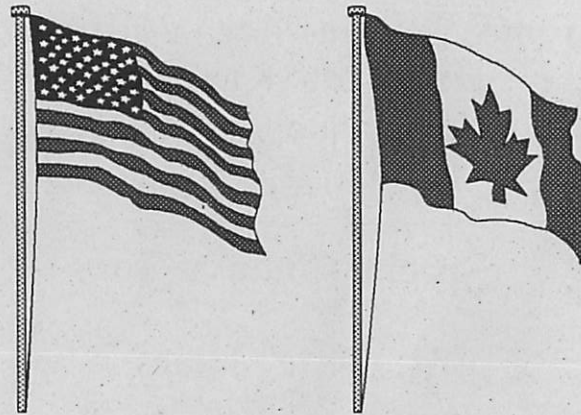
Jesse Samuel Hobson Jr. passed this life on April 15, 1994 at the Health Science Centre after a short illness.
