through the night.

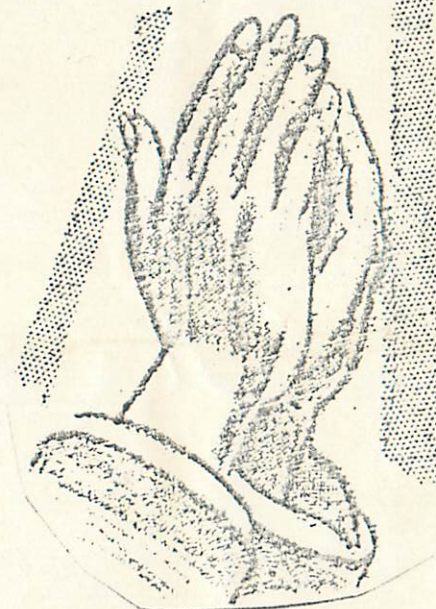
